## Winnipeg Scottish Festival Inc. "Built on Tradition"

The Winnipeg Scottish Festival Inc. is a "not for profit" organization whose primary objective is to promote knowledge, understanding and appreciation of our Scottish Culture and Heritage both past and present. We also want to help encourage the advancement of Bagpipe music now and into the future.

The Winnipeg Scottish Festival is held annually during February in Winnipeg and is hosted by the Winnipeg Scottish Festival Inc. The Festival offers pipers, drummers and pipe bands the opportunity to compete and receive adjudication from world-renowned judges. This event began as a 1-day event 16 years ago at a local high school with individual piping and drumming adjudication. It has now evolved into a very popular event on the Pipe Band circuit. We currently attract individuals and Pipe Bands from a number of Provinces as well as the United States.

## Events

Events include individual solos, Piobaireachd and light music in piping and drumming as well as full band events. Over 200 individuals compete in 47 events with as many as 15 Pipe Bands entering 12 band events. At the conclusion of the day, the audience is treated to over 300 pipers and drummers performing in a massed band.

## Cultural Display & Learning Centre

Scottish organizations and individuals display cultural and historical artifacts. This includes clan displays, Scottish crafts and presentations.

## Awards

Each competitor receives a written critique from a world-class adjudicator for each event entered. The top six individuals in each event will be awarded medals for their outstanding achievement. As well, the gold medal winners will receive a trophy. Pipe Bands receive a written critique and are also awarded trophies along with prize money. These awards are made possible through the generous support of Scottish Associations, local businesses or individuals.

## Sponsorship

Local Scottish Associations, local businesses and individuals contribute financial support by providing the festival with endorsements and advertising. Provincial and City grants are applied for annually to help make this event successful. The Scottish Festival is promoted through our Website, local newspapers, program advertising and various Scottish Community events throughout the year.
